Community Pride manages the Adopt-A-Highway program in Charleston County. This program provides groups with supplies and trash pick up for quarterly roadside cleanups.

Each year thousands of volunteers adopt and care for over 300 miles of Charleston roadways, removing an average of 50,000 lbs of litter a year.
