

▶ PalmettoPride Trash Tracker app allows citizens to take pride, take responsibility and take action against litter in the state of South Carolina. The app will allow you to report litterbugs, illegal dumpsites and areas that need attention in all 46 counties. To date, there have been an estimated 35,191 calls reporting litterbugs.
